

Resolution of the Students' Opposition on Proposed Changes to UW-System Chapter 17

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WHEREAS, the University of Wisconsin-Green Bay Student Government Association represents the 5,800 enrolled students of the University of Wisconsin-Green Bay, and

WHEREAS, we share the belief that students should not be punished academically for their conduct outside of the academic setting, and

WHEREAS, UW-Milwaukee administration has proposed changes in UWS 17 Nonacademic Misconduct policy that would academically punish students for non-Academic behavior taking place beyond the boundaries of the UWM campus, and

WHEREAS, punishing students academically for conduct in which they have already received civil and/or criminal punishment outside of the University setting is a clear violation of double-jeopardy, therefore

BE IT RESOLVED that the Student Association oppose proposed changes to UWS 17, Nonacademic Misconduct policy, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution be forwarded to the University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee Student Association to be sent to the Board of Regents and UW System President accompanied by identical legislation from other UW System campuses.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that this resolution be forwarded to UW-Green Bay administration.
